OVERVIEW:

We are seeking a brewery assistant to join the Little Brown Jug team. This position is a gateway to a career in a production brewery. The ideal candidate is eager to learn about the brewing industry and will get trained on our equipment and processes. This position begins with the primary roles listed below, with training on more advanced roles as the brewery assistant progresses. The brewery is equipped with a custom built 3-vessel 20hL brewhouse with a centrifuge, a lab, and rotary canning system. The brewery assistant would can and keg beer, clean, aid the production team in inventory management, and complete other warehouse tasks.

COMPANY:

Little Brown Jug is a production brewery in an old livery on the edge of the Exchange District in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Since opening in December 2016, Little Brown Jug has built a driven, professional, dynamic team that is encouraged to take initiative and provide input to business decisions. We are seeking a highly motivated individual who will thrive in our positive work culture.

- Organize and maintain inventory
- Assist the canning line operator during packaging
- Assist shipping and receiving duties
- Fill 8-pack boxes and prepare orders for delivery
- Organize the cold room

Advanced roles include:

- Set up keg washer & filler
- Set up & tear down canning line
- Operate the centrifuge
- CIP brite tanks, fermentors, canning line, centrifuge and keg filler
